




UCAM PROFILE



CAMPUS AND LOCATION

Universidad Católica San Antonio de Murcia was established as an educative project focused on the active presence of students, professors and other members of the college community inside the Campus.

The Campus is located at the Jerónimos Monastery (XVIII century building) with an area of over 225.000 square meters, gardens, parking, sports facilities and university residence. Together with its baroque church, it is declared as a Historical-Artistic National Monument.

Inside the Campus you will find bright and wide classrooms, library, auditoriums, meeting and working office, computers, multimedia and language rooms, labs, television and radio studios, among many other infrastructures.

The Campus is 4 km away from the urban core of the city of Murcia, in a special environment that combines peace and tranquility with good connections. But UCAM doesn't end on the Campus borders. Just 5 minutes walking, you will find UCAM Sports Center, located in an outlet shopping center, La Noria. Apart from that, there is a supermarket just a few meters away from UCAM's gate.



R+D PROJECTS

UCAM researchers are currently implementing more than 100 research and development projects. These are some of the most remarkable ones:

- · Demonstration of cyclodextrins techniques in treatment of waste water in textile industry to recover and reuse textile dyes (DYES4EVER).
- Beneficial effects of dietary bioactive peptides and polyphenols on cardiovascular risk (BACCHUSS).
- · Industrial research about diets and foods with specific features for the elderly: bioavailability assessment of bioactive ingredients.
- Effects on performance, rigidity, kinetics and kinematics of both vertical and sprint jump by using different resisted loads.
- Study about the consumption of institutional advertising communication on the Internet, mobile devices and social media: types, characteristics of users and strategic management.
- Development of a methodology for the design of an urban network of cycle pathways, using TICs and geolocators.

THE UNIVERSITY OF SPORTS

Welcome to the University of Sports in Spain.

Following the Anglo-Saxon model, sport is part of UCAM's DNA, being hailed the Champion of Universities Competitions for the second consecutive year, with 76 medals (50 gold). Among UCAM top athletes there are Olympic medalists like Mireia Belmonte and David Cal and World Champions such as Melanie Costa. The 21 federated teams sponsored and managed by UCAM include UCAM Murcia CB, a professional basketball team competing in the ACB Liga Endesa. The sports facilities are lead by the UCAM Sports Center, a high tech gym accessible to both university and local communities.

With over twenty Olympians in its ranks, UCAM, through the Spanish Olympic Committee, supports some of these prominent athletes.

The UCAM's patronage of these athletes goes beyond mere sports sponsorship. 

2. Attend the Personal Interview On-Line

- After passing the first step, you will be invited for the interview schedule
- Personal interview session with admission department

3.On-Line Registration and Application Fee

After the interview, the student must register on-line, fill in their personal data, upload academic documentation and pay the inscription fee. UCAM issues an acceptance letter which may be necessary to apply for the visa to enter in Spain. 4. Enrollment at UCAM
